CMP ORIENTATION

All competitors and spectators are required to have a current CMP card in their possession at all times while on the CMP property. If you don't have a card or if your card is expired please plan to get one as soon as you get to the range before checking in at the match registration desk. Everyone will be given a holder for the card. **Your CMP card must be worn** while on the competition or practice bays and also will be checked daily by staff. This is a requirement of the range.

PRACTICE

If you plan to practice you must pre-register and pay for practice. We will not be accepting payment for practice at the match. We have setup a "match" on PractiScore so you can register and pay. Failure to take care of this in advance will cause delays before you can practice. Please register for practice using this link https://practiscore.com/2024-wssc-practice/register.

PRACTICE BAYS


All 8 stages will be setup for Practice. Practice will run from 9:00am until 5:00pm. We reserve the right to close practice bays early if needed. Per Alabama range protection act we are prohibited from shooting prior to 9:00. The Practice bays will open Tuesday morning at 9:00. Competitors MUST have current CMP card before using the practice bays. You will be required to show your card to a range official working the practice bays.

SHIPPING AMMO TO THE RANGE

Shipments must be sent to The CMP 4387 Turner Mill Road, Talladega, AL 35160. Everything needs to be to the attention of USPSA/WSSC. Make certain your name and USPSA number are clearly visible on the outside of the package. Also remember ammo must have the Limited Quantity label and be shipped by either FedEX or UPS.

RECOGNITION

The 2024 SCSA World Speed Shooting Championship will recognize divisions and categories per the SCSA Rules, Appendix A2. Per Appendix A2, divisions and classes must have 10 or more competitors, and categories must have 5 or more competitors (within each division), to be recognized. Only qualifying Division, Class, Category, and Special Awards will be presented.

PRIZES

Cash prizes will be awarded to Steel Master, Rifle Master, Rimfire Master, and Division Winners. Winners of cash prizes will be issued vouchers and tax forms to claim their prize, which will be mailed to the address in their USPSA member profile.

Prize tables will be separated into three separate tables.

Competitors will walk a prize table for their best centerfire pistol placement by order of finish. Competitors will walk a prize table for their best rimfire rifle or pistol placement by order of finish.

Competitors will walk a prize table for their best PCC placement by order of finish.

Competitors may only walk for their highest finish in each of the three groups.

[DIVISION SPECIFICATIONS & POLICIES]

DIVISION SPECIFICATIONS

All thirteen SCSA divisions are eligible for competition at this event. For division specific requirements please consult the SCSA rules (https://scsa.org/rules) we will be using the February 2024 edition of the rule book for this event.

DISQUALIFICATION POLICY

Any competitor disqualified during the event will not be permitted to continue in the competition. This includes firearms scheduled for a later flight or the next day. Previously completed scores will remain as scored and the competitor remains eligible for awards and placement for those completed scores. Should a competitor have remaining slots registered in the event those slots are forfeited to USPSA to be resold or reassigned at their discretion.

steel challenge **RANGE POLICIES**

EYE AND EAR PROTECTION

All people on the range property must wear eye and ear protection — no exceptions. If you do not have eye and ear protection of your own, earplugs and safety glasses are available at the registration table.

COLD RANGE

All firearms on the range are to be unloaded and carried in a holster or case unless in a safety area, or at the specific command of a range officer on the line. There will be a designated area(s) for function firing and firearms handling.

SQUAD SCHEDULE

The shooting schedule will be adhered to. If a contestant arrives after their designated squad has concluded shooting, they will either fire the stage with the last squad of the day or be put with a later squad. This will be subject to the discretion of the Match Officials. The shooter may NOT reassign themselves to other squads of their choice.

PHOTOGRAPHIC RELEASE

By entering or attending the Steel Challenge, each participant authorizes unconditional use of his/ her likeness, name and match results for purposes of advertising and promotion without compensation, consideration, notice, review or consent.

PREPAREDNESS

Contestants are to go to the line prepared with the appropriate number of magazines, or speed loaders and needed ammunition, so as to not cause unnecessary delay. A contestant may have an assistant to help them in reloading magazines if needed.

ROUND COUNT

Competitors may fire as many rounds as they deem necessary for each string of fire. There are a minimum of 195 shots fired for the eight stages.

USE OF TENTS AND CANOPIES

There will be designated areas for function firing and firearms handling. The shaded holding area (canopy) at each stage is primarily for competitors. Friends and family members are allowed in this area only if not needed by competitors. Please respect the competitor's efforts by keeping the noise to a minimum. Anyone appearing to disturb a competitor's concentration will be asked to leave. **SAFETY AREAS:** The range is equipped with a number of safety areas to bag and holster guns, for dry fire practice and gun repair, etc. No ammunition may be handled in any safety area.

Parking Area: Competitor parking area is designated on the map. Competitors are not allowed to park across the bridge area or next to the bays.

RULES: The match rules are found in the current edition of the USPSA Competition Rules (2024 SCSA Rules).

OBEY YOUR RO: Range officers are here to assist you in completing a safe shooting contest. Please comply with their requests. Please bring any issues to the attention of the Range Master.

LOST BRASS: All brass is donated to the staff.

ALCOHOL: Alcohol and recreational drugs may not be consumed anywhere on the range. Competitors violating this policy will be disqualified and asked to leave the range.

DRESSCODE: Practical shooting is a sport. The match director will be the final arbiter of dubious taste.

REST ROOMS: Portable toilets are located conveniently around the range.

PARKING: Parking areas will be clearly marked on the range map. Competitors may only park in the competitor areas. Lock your car and take your valuables.

GUN HANDLING IN THE PARKING AREA IS PROHIBITED.

SPECTATORS: Everyone must wear eye protection while on the range and hearing protection is strongly suggested. Climbing on berms is not allowed. Children must be under the direct supervision of a parent. If you need eye protection, please see a range master.

LCD TIME DISPLAYS: We plan to use LCD displays that show the time as recorded on the shot timer. In the event there is any discrepancy in the time displayed on the LCD and the time recorded on the shot timer the shot timer time takes precedence and will be used for scoring.





his year's World Speed Championship Shooting (WSSC) was again at the Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) in Talladega, Alabama. The match ran from April 25th to April 30th and had 252 competitors shooting 673 guns, compared to last year's record-breaking 712 guns for 277 people. This was the sixth year that the match has been at the CMP, and if you've never been able to make it, I highly recommend it. The good news is that next year, it's coming back to the CMP and will be a little later in the year, May 28 through June 2. Every year the organization refines the match to try to make it better, but it's like polishing a diamond; at some point, it's not going to get any brighter.

This year's match had some minor refinements that proved to make it shine brighter. While the stage layouts are consistent, this year they were positioned in the bays to ensure that every plate contrasted well against the berm. They were also positioned in the bays so the illusions when a stage is in a long bay didn't exist. While these seem like minor things, every competitor I talked to

thought the stages looked great.

Challenge Shooting The Steel Association (SCSA) also took advantage of a feature when using Practiscore called Score Logging. After the shooter hits Approve, an email with the stage, their overall time and their string times was sent. This was made possible due to a dedicated Wi-Fi network that the SCSA invested in. What I learned (thanks, Zack) was that when Score Logging is used, you can refresh the Practiscore Competitor app and it will update with all of the scores posted. This allowed people to track their competition and see where they stood against them. While this helped, it should be noted that official scores are only those that are posted to the website.

I was fortunate enough to spend the

entire week at WSSC, and every day had its own flair. At the beginning of the week it was a little cooler, with some scattered rain - nothing that impacted the shooting, as they had canopies set up over the shooting boxes. The weather warmed up Friday and Saturday and again some rain came down, but nothing that impacted the match. Saturday was absolutely beautiful, warm, slightly overcast and no rain. By Sunday, the winds picked up, just enough to remove the canopies, but the temperature was perfect and there wasn't any rain. Enough on the weather, let's get to what you want to read about - the shooting!

Steel Challenge is one of the fastest

shooting sports in the world, and records were meant to be broken; this year didn't disappoint. Three match records were broken, and the previous records had been around for a while. Michael Poggie crushed the Iron Sight Revolver record (which he set in 2017 at 101.89) with a blistering 97.7. BJ Norris decimated the Production record, set back in 2015 at 87.00 with a time of 81.41. Kenshiro Nagata, not to be outdone, broke the RFRO record he set last year at 54.40 with a time of 53.53. I was able to catch a few stages of the Rimfire Rifle super squad, and watching that squad shoot was amazing.

There were also category world records set at WSSC 2023. In the

ladies category, Carleigh Chadwick set records in RFPO at 63.53 and RFRO at 58.74. Kenshiro Nagata set junior records in CO at 83.6, PCCO at 57.08, RFRI at 57.04 and RFRO at 53.53. In the senior category, Jeff Jones shot an 83.38 in PCCI. Not to be outdone, the super seniors had Clifford Pietruski in CO at 105.86 and OPN at 107.26. Chet Whistle set the RFPO record at 81.83 and Carl Simpson set records in LTD at 140.88 and SS at 135.65. Rounding out the age-based categories is the new category, distinguished senior with competitors 70-plus years of age. Categories need at least five guns to be recognized, so following that constraint, the distinguished senior world titles were in RFRO at 71.58, PCCO at 73.05 and RFPO at 91.40, all won by Karl Sutterlin. With BJ Norris now in the law enforcement category, he set records in CO at 76.44 and PROD at 81.41.

Many of the divisions have been changing hands for the number-one slot, but there are a few repeats that happened this year. KC Eusebio won his sixth title in a row in Open and Chris Barrett won his fourth title in a row in PCCI. Michael Poggie

continued his dominance in the revolver categories with his eighth title in a row in Optical Sight and his fifth (over seven years, no title was awarded in 2019 and 2022) in Iron Sight Revolver. Kenshiro Nagata repeated in RFRO with his second in a row. Looking at the ladies, Jessie Harrison won her eighth Open title (over 12 years, no title was given in 2015-2017 and 2020) and Kylie Wells defended her PCCI title with two in a row. The junior category saw repeat wins for Kenshiro Nagata in PCCO, RFPO and RFRO. In the senior category, Jeff Jones defended his PCCI title for two in a row and got his fourth title in a row in RFPO.

The SCSA has three special awards,

Steel Master, Rifle Master and Rimfire Master. All of these require proficiency in multiple guns to be able to win. At WSSC 2023, the Steel Master was won by Gregory Clement, shooting Carry Optics, Limited and Rimfire Pistol Open, with a time of 258.26. The Rifle Master was defended and won by Kenshiro Nagata shooting Pistol Caliber Carbine Optics and Rimfire Rifle Open, with a time of 110.61. While there aren't official world records kept for Rifle Master, this was the fastest Rifle Master score ever recorded at the WSSC. Rounding out the special awards with a defense of his Rimfire Master title, Grant Kunkel shot the four rimfire divisions with a total time of 266.00.

As always, the WSSC ended with the awards ceremony/banquet; again this year it was at the International Motorsports Hall of Fame. Zack and team had all of the cups and medals on display, ready to be handed out. After everyone got some food, I announced all the winners and everyone got their picture taken with Zack. The night finished with the prize tables which, when I looked them over, had some very nice prizes.

As I said earlier, if you haven't made it to the World Speed Shooting championships, I highly recommend it. I'll be there next year, hoping not to get shooshed by too many ROs (if you don't know, come to the match and find out).



Outer Limits will have three 4' x 4' shooting boxes. The shooter will start on their weak side shooting box and will engage the 20 and 35 yard plates on the weak side of the center line, move to the middle shooting box and engage the remaining two plates and stop plate. The distance between each of the three boxes will be 6'. Note: Only two of the three boxes will be used by each shooter. Depending on whether you are right or left handed, you will begin in the appropriate outside box and finish in the middle box.

AMMO SHIPPING

Here's some information for shipping your ammunition to **CMP Talladega** Shipping location:

"Your Name" Steel Challenge/WSSC 4387 Turner Mill Rd, Talladega, AL 35160 (706) 346-6469

NOTE: <u>DO NOT SHIP AMMUNITION BY THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE</u>! IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO DO SO, AND YOU WILL BE LIABLE FOR ANY LEGAL ISSUES. WE ARE CONSIDERING NOT RECEIVING ANY AMMO SHIPPED THROUGH THE POSTAL SERVICE, AND THEIR CARRIERS MAY DECLINE TO DELIVER IT. YOU MUST SHIP BY COMMERCIAL CARRIER, UPS OR FEDEX OR ANY OTHER CARRIER THAT WILL SHIP AMMO—<u>NOT</u> THE USPS.

1) Use a very sturdy box and lots of tape. Ammo is heavy and the carriers will not treat that box like a carton of eggs. Do not place ammo inside the box loose; use plastic or cardboard boxes with separators designed to hold ammunition. That's usually a requirement for all commercial carriers. Place lots of padding around the ammo boxes. **DO NOT SHIP IT IN AN ENVELOPE**.

2) Put **YOUR** name and "Steel Challenge/WSSC" on the outside of the box, in big, **bold** letters, and covered with clear tape. *Put it there in at least 3 different locations*. In addition, insert a business card, or a small piece of paper inside the box with all of your contact information. Some boxes get damaged in shipment, making the outside illegible. The information inside will help determine who the owner is, and allow them to contact you should some of your ammunition be lost due to damaged packaging.

3) UPS/FedEx will ship ammo, ground only, if it's properly marked with an ORM-D Label. Be sure to package your ammo securely in boxes designed to hold ammunition, and use a sturdy box and <u>lots</u> of tape. Most UPS stores and FedEx Office will not accept ammo shipments; you can hand them to a route person, schedule a pickup, or take them to a UPS/FedEx depot/service center.


4) Ship your ammo in time for it to arrive prior to the match. It must go ground, per UPS and/or FedEx regulations, so give it time to get there. Again: <u>NO AMMO BY US POSTAL SERVICE</u>. The folks at CMP Marksmanship Park will collect your ammunition and store it until USPSA personnel are on the ground at the range. We (USPSA) will distribute it at or around registration or during the match. It will be better if you collect your ammunition during registration periods so that we can assure that we have people on hand to distribute it. You may be required to sign for any ammunition you pick up. If you want to collect your ammo at times other than registration, you may experience a delay in getting it until someone is free.
